



- Assemble the anchor kit, nut, and screw in order.
 Fix the faucet's position and direction. Next assemble the screw and tighten with the appropriate tool.
- 2 Connect blue marking hose
 1 to cold water supply, and red marking hose 2 to hot water supply. Use wrenches to tighten connections. Do not overtighten. Note: angle valves not included.
